Few interested parties have time to time asked some queries, therefore a following clarifications are being uploaded for benefits of all interested parties in the EOI.

Financial Proposal/financial quote/price

This EOI is for shortlisting of the potential consultants for techno-commercial feasibility study for an integrated Soda Ash Plant. The shortlisting will be based on the process as given in the EOI documents. At this stage, financial quotes are not required and the interested parties are requested not include any Financial proposal/financial quote/price. The interested parties are also requested to strictly follow the instructions given in the EOI documents.

After shortlisting of the interested parties who will meet the criteria, a Request for Proposal (RFP) shall be issued in due course only to the shortlisted parties for further process including submission of the Technical and Financial proposal.

Scope of Work

The Scope of Work given under Section-5 is indicative. As mentioned in Section-5 that this list of Scope of Work of the Project is inclusive of but not exhaustive list of all the requirements and that the successful Applicant(s) as Consultant shall be required to perform/undertake all such necessary studies/actions/activities which shall ensure the successful planning of techno-commercial strategy of such projects.

Project Locations:

Under Section-4, the locations are indicated as PMDC Operating Rock Salt Projects at Khewra, Makrach, Warcha or KalaBagh. However, the Scope of Work also includes that the consultant shall propose the suitable site based on their consideration of the study i.e. design parameters, supply/demand, logistics etc.

Salt Mines PMDC plans to undertake complete techno-commercial feasibility study for setting up an integrated Soda Ash and Bi-products processing Plant meeting international standards based on its Khewra, Makrach, Warcha or KalaBagh Salt Mines, as the techno commercial feasibility study would recommend.
